We are truly blessed by an Almighty God who strengthens and upholds. The last few weeks have been difficult as the three of us, Lois, Shad, and Fitz, have all had physical challenges such as the terrible cold/flu/cough going around plus strong allergy attacks, little sleep, and a very busy schedule. In spite of everything, we only missed one meeting, and have had meetings every Sunday and Wednesday, and even a Sunday evening too. Praise!



Now we are leaving on a six-week tour visiting friends, family, and supporters. We will drive to Montana visiting on the way both supporters and churches, then fly to Minnesota, Wisconsin, Georgia, and on to Virginia to visit the Gravinos and visit other churches. Then we will fly back to Montana to get the car and drive back to California visiting other supporters on the way.

That leaves three weeks before we leave for Kenya on June 6th. Those weeks are also booked for Sunday and Wednesdays. All this to say we really need your prayers for safety, health, and more monthly supporters. So far we have been promised about half of the support needed to open eleven new churches. We were working to get support for ten, but while we have been here, they have opened a fourth fellowship in Uganda.



The pastors in Kenya have been working hard and getting much done. We thank God for their faithfulness, and we are so blessed. No matter how far we go, someone just beyond asks us to come.

Please pray for wisdom as we have a lot of decisions to make. Before we left Kenya, the guys and a visiting chalk artist were involved in a small accident and were detained at a police station. About midnight the chalk artist got out his materials and began preaching to everyone. One policeman got saved, and another said that God had brought them there so they would repent. God is so good at turning even our accidents into blessings! Thanks for partnering with us. Please continue to pray for our families back home.
